# AUSSIE STARTUPS TAKE HOME CASH PRIZES, OVERSEAS TRIPS AND COVETED AWARDS AT NATIONAL TECH INNOVATION EVENT, TECH23

**SYDNEY, 10 October 2017:** The winners of Australia's national celebration of deep tech innovation have been announced, with AI, DNA and education technologies among those taking home awards.

Running for almost a decade, <u>Tech23</u> is a community-focused event which helps startups make connections with investors, mentors, customers, and more.

The crowd favourite taking home this year's Tech23 People's Choice Award was <u>Xplor</u>, a system to transform the way we approach learning.

The Tech23 Innovation Excellence Award went to <u>Nucleotrace</u> for their supply chain monitoring and anti-counterfeiting technology, which uses fragments of DNA as a non-toxic molecular fingerprint.

The winner of Tech23's Greatest Potential Award was <u>Presagen</u> for an AI-driven platform that automates human behaviour and medical diagnostics.

This year Tech23 startups were vying not only for cash prizes but trips to the U.S., China and landing pads in Israel and Germany. Winners of the travel prizes included <u>Elula</u> - who won a trip to Boston; <u>Modular Photonics</u> - who won the Austrade Going Global Award and will visit landing pads in Berlin and Tel Aviv; <u>Presagen</u>, who will have lunch with Upguard in California; and <u>Flurosat</u>, who won the China Australia Millennial Project award, a five-day immersion tour through Beijing's innovation ecosystem.

Some of the Tech23 startups also nabbed meetings with influential members of Australia's tech ecosystem. <u>Pedestal</u> won a lunch with CEO of Smart Sparrow, Dror Ben Naim; <u>Sofihub</u> will meet

with investor Simon Martin; <u>Modular Photonics</u> will meet with the founder of eServ, Ian Buddery; <u>Syntropy</u> scored a meeting with Square Peg Capital; <u>EpiSoft</u> with Michelle Deaker, Managing Partner of OneVentures; and <u>Platfarm</u> will meet with Elaine Stead, Head of Blue Sky Venture Capital.

Leading Australian R&D institutions were also on-hand at Tech23's Innovation Island, with representation from CSIRO, Austrade Landing Pads Program, EnergyLab, University of Sydney's Incubate, Macquarie University Incubator, and UTS: Hatchery.

This year's Tech23 companies join a stellar alumni including SmartSparrow, Clevertar, BuildingIQ, Culture Amp, Marathon Targets, Binu, Local Measure, AgriWebb, and Plutora.
